Protection Phase <i>Weeks 0 - 2</i>	Okay for shoulder PROM/AAROM as tolerated. Wrist and elbow ROM encouraged	Sling w/ abduction pillow until block wears off Sling for comfort only	<u>Ice</u> : 20 minutes on, 20 minutes off every hour <u>Exercises</u> : Pendulums, Active ROM as tolerated
Therapy Phase 1 Weeks 2 - 6	Progress AROM as tolerated with gentle passive stretching at end ranges	D/C sling	<u>Exercises</u> : Begin light resisted ER, FF, ABD: Isometrics, bands <u>Modalities</u> : Per therapist – E-stim, Ultrasound, heat (before), ice (after)
Therapy Phase 2 Weeks 6 - 12	Progress AROM as tolerated	None	Exercises: Okay to progress strengthening once ROM is pain-free. <u>Modalities</u> : Per therapist – E-stim, Ultrasound, heat (before), ice (after)
Therapy Phase 3 Weeks 12+	ROM as tolerated	None	Begin eccentric motions, plyometrics, and closed chain exercises as tolerated
